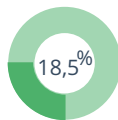

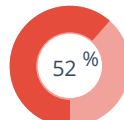

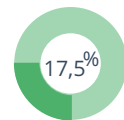

Of all grapes grown in South Africa is Chenin blanc



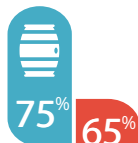
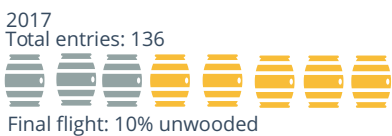
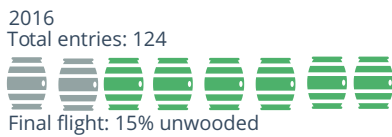
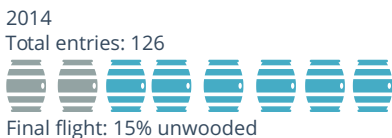

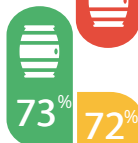

## Tasting protocol

- The wines are tasted blind, with no indication of vintage, cellar treatment or technical analysis.
- Scored by five-person panel, scoring done according to 20-point system.
- Each judge starts at a different point in the flight, to prevent the halo effect/combat palate fatigue.
