

Nestled in South Africa's fertile Breede River Valley region, Alvi's Drift winery boasts a long and storied history. Meet our family and get to know our farm, our vineyards, our cellar, and our award-winning wines.

In the Alvi's Drift cellar, modern and traditional production techniques are applied in tandem with a low-intervention, unhurried approach to wine making.

Here, oak barrels, giant stainless steel fermentation tanks and hitech winemaking equipment share a home with so-called kuipvate, the concrete, open-top fermentation tanks constructed by our family patriarch almost a hundred years ago.

The Alvi's Drift cellar is where head winemaker Alvi van der Merwe and his team live out their passion for crafting our 9 000-tonne winery's much-awarded, internationally acclaimed white, red, rosé and sparkling wines.

# **Beaumont Family Wines**



Beaumont is a family owned and managed farm situated in the heart of the town of Bot River ("Botter Rivier") in the Overberg.

The farm, home to the region's oldest wine cellar, was originally established in the 1700s by the Dutch East India Company as a supply farm producing fruit, vegetables, dairy, wine and flour.

Jayne and Raoul Beaumont bought the farm, Compagnes Drift, in 1974 and set about replanting the vineyards. The farm was transformed through hard work and an adventurous spirit. Raoul was a maverick of the vineyards and motorcycles and Jayne an artist, teacher and mother. Jayne pioneered the first wine, making small amounts of Pinotage bearing her hand-drawn label in the late 1970s.

The legacy of wine made under the family name was cemented with the first bottle of Beaumont Pinotage, produced in 1994. Since then, the wines have born the crest of the Beaumont family. The roaring lion represents honour and courage and serves as a symbolic message of balance – a quality synonymous with our wines.

### **Beaumont Chenin 2023**

This is fruit filled unwooded Chenin Blanc. The 2023 vintage produced very healthy grapes full of flavour and great intensity. It is a delicious example of cooler climate Chenin Blanc fermented in concrete and stainless-steel tanks using a combination of cultured and natural yeasts. Matured after fermentation on the lees to add some extra weight and complexity to the wine.

### **Beaumont Hope Marguerite 2023**

Named after Hope Marguerite Beaumont, a woman with character, elegance and a love for wine. Our first vintage of the Hope Marguerite was produced in 1997 and at that time there were only two other Chenin Blancs in South Africa produced in this style. Only fruit selected from our two oldest Chenin Blanc vineyards, planted in '74 and '78, are used for this wine. Both these vineyards are registered as single vineyards and the wine is certified as a Heritage Vineyard wine.

Chenin Blanc is the winemaker, Andries Blake's favourite white varietal. The blocks for this Chenin Blanc were especially selected by the winemaker from vineyards in the Olifantsriver. ## **Boland Cellar**

Boland Cellar is located in the heart of the Cape's winemaking region, just outside the picturesque town of Paarl, South Africa. This pre-eminent producer has a holistic approach to sustainability, beginning with the vision to sustain a future livelihood for the more than 40 wine grape producers who supply to Boland Cellar, as well as their families, farm workers and the greater rural community.

Boland Cellar's expansive supplier base means its skilled winemaking team has access to grapes carefully selected from five climate zones and nearly 2 000 hectares of exquisite terroir. This includes prized vineyard sites from the Paardeberg and its surrounds to the Drakenstein Mountains, Swartland, Berg River Valley and coastal areas – variety that makes for nuanced wines and something to delight every wine lover within the Boland portfolio.

### **Melita Chenin Blanc Light 2024**

For this, Boland Cellar has collaborated with Greenpop Forests for Life Programme, an organisation to bring about real and meaningful benefits to agriculture and bee population health. The name Melita has its origin in ancient Greek mythology and is derived from the goddess Melissa who was regarded as the keeper of bees and honey-making.

### **Arum Lily Chenin Blanc 2023**

The cellar's signature variety, Chenin Blanc, is sourced from old vineyard blocks of bush-vines from the northern Paardeberg region where small yields are harvested in mid to late February from partially water-stressed vines. The shale and granite soils play an important role in imparting structure and minerality to this complex wine. These old vines are well adapted and fairly resistant to strong winds and hot conditions.

## **Cavalli Wine Estate**



Cavalli Estate is a true marvel, a captivating oasis that seamlessly blends luxury, artistry, and the enchanting essence of the winemaking craft. This remarkable estate, owned and operated by a remarkable team of women, stands as a testament to the power of passion and expertise. From the award-winning wines that capture the essence of the terroir to the stunning vistas that leave visitors in awe, every element of Cavalli Estate exudes an unparalleled level of elegance and refinement. It is a place where the art of winemaking meets the grandeur of nature, creating an experience that is truly spellbinding.

### Cavalli Unoaked Chenin Blanc 2024

Grapes were harvested in the early morning to ensure that they maintained an optimal temperature before being processed. In the cellar the grapes were whole bunch pressed. The juice was settled over two days and racked off the lees into stainless steel tanks. The current yeast strain used, enhances the tropical fruit profile of the wine. The wine spent 6 weeks post fermentation on the lees before preparations for bottling started.

### **Cavalli Chenin Blanc 2023**

Grapes were hand-picked in the early morning at Cavalli in three separate pickings. Grapes were whole bunch pressed and settled overnight to achieve good clarity of juice. We ran several trials this season comparing different yeast species and strains, as well as increasing our proportion of spontaneous ferments. The wine remained in 225L French oak barrels on its lees for 6 months before blending, of which 20% were first fill barrels. During this time very minimal malolactic fermentation took place, leaving a fresh bright acidity.

It was in 2002 that the Swiss-born winemaker Jean-Claude Martin and his South African wife, Carolyn née Finlayson, first discovered their little piece of paradise on the Hemel-en-Aarde Ridge of South Africa's acclaimed Walker Bay Wine Region. Establishing a winery in a remote corner where there were neither vineyards nor infrastructure presented many challenges. Yet inspiration, innovation and sheer determination won the day. Both Jean-Claude and Carolyn come from wine pioneering families spanning three generations and the vast potential of the exceptional terroir was motivation enough.

At Creation a diverse blend of geology, soils, altitude, aspect and climate gives rise to the production of an exciting variety of terroir-reflective wines. The estate's key focus is Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. There are no less than four Chardonnays and four Pinot Noirs in the Creation portfolio, offering consumers a choice of site-specific wines grown in virus-free vineyards and made with little intervention.

David & Nadia is a family owned Swartland driven project and we focus on a spectrum of organic, old and dry land bush vine vineyards from different areas with different soil types throughout the Swartland, farmed by like-minded people. We are members of the Swartland Independent Producers.

In the vineyard we aim for biological farming and in the cellar we work as natural as possible. It is all about the soil and vineyards after all. We believe in a pure, fresh and natural style where site and soil are at work with minimal influence from a winemaking point of view.

#### Chenin Blanc 2022

Our main Chenin Blanc from the Swartland is made from 19 pickings from 8 vineyards, ranging from 1968 till 1986. The wine is based on granite from the Paardeberg, blended with shale/schist from the east, more clay rich soils from the north and iron rich soils from the western parts of the Swartland. The wine has a Certified Heritage Vineyards (CHV) seal.

### **Skaliekop Chenin Blanc 2022**

These vines were planted in 1985 in very shallow shale soils in the Paardeberg, being an anomaly as the mountain is granite driven. These soils prove why our region is known for wheat farms as it remains a difficult soil for vineyards in a warm region in a dryland farming context. A narrow tractor road divides the Plat'bos and Skaliekop vineyards. Skaliekop was harvested mid-February on two picking dates.

# **Dornier**





Dornier is a family owned winery situated in The Golden Triangle area of the upper Blaauwklippen Valley Stellenbosch. The primary focus at Dornier lies in the production of premium quality wines with minimal intervention which are expressive of the unique terroir of The Golden Triangle whilst showcasing the complexity and finesse of the noble grape varieties planted at Dornier. Reverence for tradition is salient at Dornier as is difference where it leads to improvement.

Dornier Wine Estate is located on 3 different farms in the Upper Blaauwklippen Valley namely Groenkloof, Heldemeer and Stellenrust (Homestead) the latter of which includes a historic Sir Herbert Baker designed homestead and one of the first wine cellars ever built in Stellenbosch in the late 1600s.

Quest Old Vine Chenin Blanc is made from old vines planted in 1985, and over the last three vintages this textured wine available at FOB \$5.95 has been awarded 95pts Decanter, 95pts IWC and voted as one of the best South African White Wines by IWSC's Club Oenologique.

With over 25 years of winemaking experience gained in South Africa and a number of wineries around the world, including chateau Margaux in France and Peter Lehmann wines in Australia, David Finlayson is a name synonymous with producing wines from top quality Burgundian and Bordeaux grape varieties alike.

Born and raised in Stellenbosch and a third generation grape grower and vintner, David Finlayson and his family purchased the run down Edgebaston farm in 2004 and began the painstaking replanting and rebuilding process to create the picturesque 30 hectare vineyard that is the Edgebaston vineyard today.

Made from block 7, which is split into two smaller blocks, where the row direction is perpendicular to one another. This allows for a complex flavour in the final product.

## **Stettyn Family Vineyards**



The history of Stettyn Family Vineyards begins in 1714 with land being granted to Jan Cloete and Jan Jurgen Radyn by the then Governor of the Cape Colony, Mauritz Pasques de Chavonnes. It got its name from Radyn's hometown of Stettin, or Szczecin, in north-western Poland.

Stettyn lies in the splendid isolation of a winemaking region and majestic valley between Villiersdorp and Worcester. We make this wine in a very tight style, so after a year in the bottle the wine had time to settle and flesh out a bit. The nose shows limy and citrus floral notes with honeysuckle and sweet pears. The palate has a balanced acidity with sweeter flavours of white peaches and apricots. The wine ends very smooth and minerally. This single vineyard is planted on a North-Western slope on clay soil with decomposed granite at 320m altitude. The vineyards is 34 years old and yields 4T/Ha.

This was a great harvest season which will produce remarkable wines. Enough rain in the growing season left enough water in the soils to sustain proper growth for ripening of the grapes without stressing. Summer temperatures were moderate during the ripening period, with the absence of characteristic heat peaks. These conditions bode particularly well for flavour retention in the grapes.

The grapes were brought in early in the morning for whole bunch pressing. The juice started a cold fermentation in the stainless steel tanks and after fermenting half of the sugar off, we slowly pumped to one 500L Amphorae clay pot, 2x500L and 1x300L neutral French oak barrels. After ferment the wine was kept on the leese for 8 months before sulphering and racking off the leese. Bottling was done on 7 November 2022.

## **Tierhoek Wines**



Tierhoek's cellar and vineyards are nestled in a mountain bowl of the Skimmelberg mountains part of the rugged peaks of the Piekenierskloof, 760m above sea level, where the vines remain dormant during the cold winters. Tierhoek's small volumes allow focus to be maintained on producing quality wines.

The vines come to life at the same time as the mountain flowers and are kept cool by the soft summer breezes of the Atlantic Ocean, producing wines of intense fruit flavours and minerality.

The Marais family began farming Tierhoek in 1886, and in 2001 new owners, Shelley Sandell and her late husband Tony, restored the Sandveld buildings and nurtured the neglected 47-year-old Chenin Blanc and Grenache vines back to working condition.

The term Sandveld is not strictly defined, sometimes being applied to the geographical area, traditionally the sandy plains between Tierhoek and the coast, or used to describe areas of sparse, open vegetation. In a more holistic sense it refers to the "going back in time feel" that the farmhouse at Tierhoek embodies, in both its architectural style, with thick whitewashed walls, and the practical, simple furniture, made from local fruit woods (in particular orange wood).

Fully ripe grapes were handpicked. A small percentage ( $\pm$  1.5%) of botrytis is considered desirable and adds further complexity. Picking occurred in the mornings when conditions were cooler and the barrel fermented Chenin Blanc comes from an Old Certified Heritage Vineyard Block.

In 2023 the fruit was crushed and destalked prior to ±4 hours of skin contact. After a light pressing in pneumatic bag presses the juice was settled overnight before being racked to barrels. MLF was prevented to retain freshness. After natural fermentation the wine remained in barrel for 10 months with regular batonage (stirring of lees). 40% of the barrels were new French oak and the balance 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3rd fill. Finally, after stabilization, the wine was bottled in December.
